MASK REQUIRED FOR ENTRY



PER EMERGENCY ORDINANCE NO. 42309 OF THE CITY OF OMAHA EFFECTIVE AUGUST 11, 2020

All individuals age five and older must wear a mask when they are in an indoor space that is open to the public unless six feet of separation from others can be achieved at all times.

Masks are not required for those:

- Seated at a bar or restaurant while consuming food or beverages
- · Engaged in exercise
- Engaged in an occupation that prevents the wearing of a mask
- Purchasing goods or services that require a mask be temporarily removed
- · Speaking to an audience where six feet of distance is maintained
- Seeking state or county government services
- Individuals who cannot otherwise wear a face covering because of a medical condition, mental health condition or a disability that makes it unreasonable for the individual to wear a mask
- Individuals seated at a desk or work station that has a solid plastic barrier which has been approved by the Health Director of the City of Omaha
